Eligible Breeds:

LGRA: Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Medio/Grande, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds Silken Windhound and Sloughi.

NOTRA: Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, and Sloughi.

LGRA Race Meet: Race meets will be 3 programs, 4-dog races, 200-yard drag lure. All breeds except Irish Wolfhounds and Scottish Deerhounds will start from the box.

NOTRA Race Meet: Race meet will be 3 programs, 4-dog races, 350-meter modified Uval. All breeds except Irish Wolfhounds and Scottish Deerhounds will start from the box.

Box dimensions: Length: 48", Width: 16", Height: 36"

Eligibility to compete:

All hounds must be 1 year of age, or older, on the day of the race meet, and must be neither lame, sick, nor in season.

Each hound must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC), Canadian Kennel Club (CKC), United Kennel Club (UKC), the National Greyhound Association (NGA), or any recognized foreign registry for pure-bred progeny of Gazehound breeds. Hounds registered with the AKC under Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) or Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or the CKC equivalent may also be entered.

First Time Entry (FTE) & Dogs with 3 Incomplete Meets

Any FTE dog as well as any dog that has ONLY incomplete meets for its last 3 meets will be required to have a certification run prior to the Nationals.

Definition of FTE and 3 Incomplete Meets

- FTE: A dog that is being entered in completion for the first time.
- 3 Incomplete Meets in NOTRA: The Grading Guide shows that all the last 3 meets had a designation of off course (oc), did not finish (dnf), or incomplete (y) next to the date of the meet.
- 3 Incomplete Meets in LGRA: The Grading Guide shows a "y" next to the score of the last 3 meets.

Proof of certification shall include:

- The name and signature of the Race Secretary who qualified the dog.
- The name of the club that the Race Secretary represents
- The date of certification.
- A statement that the dog came out of the racing box and ran the entire track cleanly with another dog of the same breed or one with a similar racing style. See the form at the end of this premium. You may use this form or a substitute, if the required information is included.

FTE Dogs & Incomplete Meets (continued)

Proof of certification can be presented either

- With the entry form OR
- At roll call
- If a dog cannot find a meet for certification prior to the Nationals, the host clubs will set up a track for certification purposes on Friday, October 31st at the Kingwood Park for LGRA only. The restrictions on this are:
 - Your dog MUST be already entered in the Nationals LGRA meet.
 - You MUST make arrangements prior to the event by calling Terri Jones at 732-261-3587 OR by e-mailing Terri at SnoopyRockyMom@gmail.com.
 - These certification runs will be BY APPOINTMENT ONLY to ensure that somebody is at the field when you arrive.
 - You must provide a dog that your dog will certify with.
 - Only one FTE may run for certification at a time.
- A dog that is an FTE in NOTRA, but has competed successfully in LGRA, must STILL provide proof of certification in NOTRA before it is allowed to compete in NOTRA; however, a dog that is an FTE in LGRA and has competed successfully in NOTRA (can show a complete meet in the NOTRA grading guide) OR has completed a successful certification run will not have to provide proof of certification to compete in LGRA.
- Unfortunately, we can NOT set up a NOTRA certification track on the day before the nationals, so you MUST be certified prior to the event.

Friday practices

Box training and practices (only for dogs entered in the event) will be held on Friday afternoon. There is a fee of \$5 per dog.

Entries:

There are no entries allowed on the day of the meet. All entries must be received by **9:00 pm on Wednesday, October 15th, 2025**. All entry fees **MUST** be received with the completed entry form and worksheet.

Entry Fees:

Entry fee is \$30 for the first dog each day and \$25 for each additional dog. Five or more dogs, same owner, is \$125 for each event.

If your dog is entering either sport for the first time, there is an additional \$2 fee per sport that must be remitted with your entry. You will see a place to remit that fee on the entry worksheet.

If at roll call, your dog is lame or in season, your entry fees will be refunded.

Roll Call and Inspection:

7:30 am SHARP each day. Racers that are not present at roll call will be marked absent and are **not** eligible for refund. Racers will be inspected for lameness, sickness, being in season, and correct fit of racing muzzle. Please bring your muzzles to roll call.

Retired racers (Legends)

We are going to have a special place in our catalog for our dogs who are no longer racing. We are offering half-price full-page ads in our catalog for Legends. We would love to see them!

Eligibility to be in our LEGENDS section is as follows:

- Your hound may NOT be entered in the regular meet.
- Must be retired from racing.
- Must be 6 years old or older.
- Must have earned at least a GRC title in LGRA or an ORC title in NOTRA.

Veterans:

A ribbon will be awarded to the high-scoring veteran in each breed.

Eligibility is as follows:

- Your hound **MUST** complete all 3 programs
- Must be 7 years of age or older on the day of the meet (5 for Irish Wolfhounds).

Eligibility: any sighthound that competed in LGRA or NOTRA (whether the owner is present, or not) that has gone to the Rainbow Bridge.

Take Route 202 Southbound to Flemington. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto NJ-12 West. At the next traffic circle take the 3rd exit onto NJ-12 West/Frenchtown Flemington Road. Turn left onto Kingwood Road. Turn left onto Union Road. The field will be on your left.

Northbound (through Lahaska, PA):

Take Route 202 Northbound to Lahaska. Take a slight left onto PA 263 N towards New Jersey. Continue onto Bridge Street. Turn left onto N Main Street. N Main Street becomes NJ-29 N / Risler Street. Continue onto Delaware Raritan Station / Kingwood Stockton Rd. Continue onto Kingwood Rd. Continue onto Kingwood Rd. Turn right onto Union Rd. The field will be on your left. (please note the bridge here has a 5 ton weight limit, AND a 12" overhead height restriction).

From Route 78

Eastbound (through Easton, PA):

Take I-78 Eastbound into NJ. Continue to exit 11, toward Pattenburg. Take a slight right onto Baptist Church Rd. Turn left onto Bloomsbury Rd. Turn right onto Mechlin Corner Rd. Turn right onto Everittstown Rd. Turn left onto Hog Hollow Rd. Continue onto Palmyra Corner Rd. Continue onto Kingwood Rd. Turn left onto Union Rd. The field will be on your left.

Westbound (through Lebanon, NJ):

Take I-78 Westbound towards PA. Continue to exit 15 toward Pittstown. Turn left onto Pittstown Rd / Pottstown-Clinton Rd. Turn right onto Country Rd 513 S. Turn left onto Hog Hollow Rd. Continue onto Palmyra Corner Rd. Continue onto Kingwood Rd. Turn left onto Union Rd. The field will be on your left.
